

**On June 6, storms roared through Terrell Hills with hurricane force winds, bringing down trees and leaving streets clogged with branches and debris.**



Terrell Hills City Manager, Greg Whitlock, has approved emergency debris removal on a temporary basis with the help of Kristin and Dick Tips, to the vacant lots the Tips own on the corner of Grandview and Eldon.

The Tips have volunteered to allow the City and Terrell Hills residents to store the fallen trees and limbs from the June 6 storm on their property and to provide the resources of Mission Park Funeral Chapels and Cemeteries to turn the debris into useful gardening mulch over the next several weeks. The temporary storage of the debris is saving the City significant amounts of money and allowing for the streets to be cleared promptly.

Residents who would like to take advantage of free gardening mulch once the trees and branches have gone through the Mission Park chippers can contact the City office for instructions.
