New Lifesaving Equipment for the Police Department!



The Terrell Hills Police Department recently took delivery of 2 Automated External Defibrillators or AED's. The AED's will be carried in the patrol cars for rapid deployment in the event a person is experiencing a sudden cardiac emergency. Often, police officers on patrol have the ability to be the first responders to any incident in city. This will allow a cardiac patient to receive lifesaving care prior to the arrival of the Fire Department or EMS. Prior to the AED's being placed in service, all officers completed joint training with the Fire Department to become proficient with the AED's and refresh their CPR skills. While Terrell Hills officers have been trained in CPR for a number of years, the new AED's represent a "best practice" in the chain of survival for patients with a sudden cardiac emergency.
