Proper care should always be taken when disposing of coals or ash. Ash and coals from a BBQ pit on a deck can easily fall below the decking starting a fire that will quickly spread. Always closely supervise your cooking and have a water source or fire extinguisher nearby. Several fires have occurred in Terrell Hills as a result of outside cooking operations.
