2. Review/Action of minutes from: April 14, 2025, City Council meeting.

The minutes were reviewed, Mayor Low called for a motion to approve the minutes as submitted, Mitchell motioned, Ballantyne seconded, all voted in favor, and the motion passed.

3. Comments by Citizens.

7. Discussion/Provide Staff Direction: On canceling July council meeting.

Mayor Low cancelled the meeting, there were no objections. Foley noted that the road project in June might be cause for a meeting on July 14th. Mayor Low advised to keep it cancelled for now and if there was a need to meet, they may have to move up the date in July.

8. Discussion/Provide Staff Direction: Selection of streets for the next road project.

Baldarrama gave an overview of streets needing repair, council and staff discussed options, council advised staff to focus on prioritizing the 500 block of Elizabeth, the 600 block of Canterbury Hill and the Amsbury section connected to it.
